Accessibility Policy

This Accessibility Statement covers the period from September 2016 – September 2017.

We are committed to providing a fully accessible environment which values and includes all children, staff, parents and visitors regardless of their education, physical, sensory, social, spiritual, emotional and cultural needs. We are committed to challenging negative attitudes about disability and accessibility and to developing a culture of awareness, tolerance and inclusion.

Birley Primary Academy plans to:

- Improve access to the **physical environment** of the Academy, adding specialist facilities as necessary. This covers improvements to the physical environment and physical aids to access education.
- Increase access to the curriculum for children with a disability, differentiating the
 curriculum as necessary to ensure that children with a disability are as equally prepared
 for life as are the non-disabled children. This covers teaching and learning and the
 wider curriculum of the Academy such as participation in after school clubs, leisure and
 cultural activities, off site visits etc. It also includes the provision of specialist aids and
 equipment, which may assist disabled children in accessing the curriculum.
- Improve the delivery of written information to children, staff, parents and visitors with disabilities. This will include handouts, timetables, textbooks and information about the Academy and its events. We plan to make this information available in various preferred formats within a reasonable time frame.

Action Plans will be developed as required, but currently we meet all requirements.

The Policy will be monitored through the School Council and governors.
